

STUDENT BENEFITS

Student purchasing behaviour is directly related to the cost of course materials.

 When students are unable to afford their course material it can have a harmful impact on academic success.

69% of students say they would earn better grades if they had access to all their course material before the first day of class.

Wakefield Research [2018] study "Majority of college students delay purchasing textbooks due to cost."

85% of students delay or avoid purchasing required course material. 91% say that decision was due to cost.

Students arrive to class with access to all their course materials - ready to learn.






ADOPTION PROCESS

Submitting adoptions has never been easier.

- LINK-BASED LOGIN log in via a personalized link, no password necessary.
- RE-ADOPT PAST TITLES FAST past adoption history shown for each course, so it's easy to re-adopt.
- SMART BOOK SEARCH search algorithm factors in title popularity to help find the right course materials fast.
