Pre-Admission GUIDELINES for UBC MASTER OF PHYSICAL THERAPY

The Master of Physical Therapy degree, at the University of British Columbia, provides the professional education necessary to obtain a licence to practice physical therapy. Admission to MPT is offered on a competitive basis with **140 seats** available each year, including 7 seats designated for Indigenous applicants and up to 8 seats for international applicants. The program is offered at four locations:

Completion of a four-year recognized bachelor's degree (120 credits) in any field with a minimum overall average in the 76% (UBC converted scale) range in all senior level (3000/4000) courses and completion of the stated prerequisites with a minimum grade of 72% (UBC converted scale) in each course.

TRU offers an opportunity to qualify with admission into the Bachelor of Arts or Bachelor of Science.

- 1. For Options A and C above, BIOL 1592 **and** 1692 must be taken together for the credit to apply. 3 credits will apply towards the Human Anatomy requirement and the remaining 3 credits will apply towards the Human Physiology requirement. All courses must be taken in order to be considered and need to be accompanied by a further 3 credits of advanced physiology or exercise physiology.
- 2. For BIOL 3540 and 3550, the following exclusions apply:
 - BIOL 3540 students may receive credit at TRU for only one of BIOL 3540 and BIOL 1592
 - BIOL 3550 students may receive credit at TRU for only one of BIOL 3550 and BIOL 1692
