Wash hands.																
Assemble equipment prior to venipuncture.																
Ensure correct patient identification.																
Ensure patient is in a safe and accessible position.																
Put on gloves.																
Select the appropriate venipuncture site.																
Cleanse site, using appropriate disinfectant and technique.																
Apply tourniquet correctly.																
Perform venipuncture, including:																
<ul> <li>Anchoring the vein.</li> </ul>																
<ul> <li>Smooth and quick insertion of the needle.</li> </ul>																
<ul> <li>Stillness of the needle in the patient's arm.</li> </ul>																
<ul> <li>Prompt and appropriate mixing of specimen.</li> </ul>																
<ul> <li>Release of the tourniquet prior to needle removal.</li> </ul>																
<ul> <li>Application of pressure to the puncture site with a clean gauze or cotton swab.</li> </ul>																
Dispose of waste materials (including needles) properly.																
Perform multiple draws.
